Career Exposure Summer Bootcamps – July 4 – 14, 2017

The goal of the NGPS Career Exposure Summer Bootcamps is to encourage youth to explore their interests and talents and develop skills, while earning credits, during these unique, hands-on educational camps. The Bootcamps are designed to enhance learning opportunities and provide career explorations that may not be available during the school year.

Camps run for 1 or 2 weeks depending on the camp:

Robotics:	July 4 – 8	One week camp (3 credits)
Safety Certification:	July 4 – 8	One week camp (5 credits)
First Aid for Animals:	July 10 – 14	One week camp (1 credit)
Medical Minds:	July 10 – 14	One week camp (3 credits)
Business Enterprise:	July 10 – 14	One week camp (3 credits)
Forestry & Forestry Equipment Operation:	July 4- 14	Two Week Camp (6 credits)
Construction:	July 4 – 14	Two week camp (6 credits)
Class 1 Truck Driver Training:	July 4 – 14	Two week camp (3 credits)
Cisco Networking:	July 4 - 14	Two week camp (5 credits)
Art:	July 4 – 14	Two week camp (5 credits)
Coding an App:	July 4 – 14	Two week camp (5 credits)
Culinary Arts:	July 4 – 14	Two week camp (4 credits)
