A Comprehensive Approach to Planning and Reporting

The Board received a draft of the publication *"A Comprehensive Approach – Looking Back: Annual Education Results Report 2014-2015 and Moving Forward: Three Year Education Plan 2015-2018."* This document is a combination of the Annual Education Results Review Report and the Three Year Education Plan.

A requirement of the Alberta Education, the Annual Education Results Review Report (AERR) outlines achievements in the Division, outcomes of strategies from the Three Year Education Plan, highlights of capital plans, school highlights, strategies for success, as well as future challenges.

Also a requirement of Alberta Education, the Three-Year Education Plan addresses the goals of the Division and its progress towards reaching those goals, Strategies and outcomes set by the Division and the government lists, with progress in the various areas outlined. Results of Provincial Achievement Tests and Diploma Examinations are also reported.

Fox Creek for the Children Fundraising Society
