Exchange teachers from Iceland spend week with NGPS

Icelandic exchange teachers, Svava Thorhildur Hjaltalin, Alda Askelsdottir and Hulda Maria Magnusdottir, and Fox Creek School Principal, Ian Baxter, met with the Board to share their experiences and learning in Fox Creek since they arrived, as part of the Alberta-Iceland Educational Exchange project (ALICE). As part of the project, six students and three teachers from Iceland have traveled to Fox Creek and will reside with host students and staff, while attending classes and work-shadowing their Canadian counterparts at Fox Creek School. The teachers shared a meal with NGPS trustees as they discussed education philosophy, policy and practice, and their experiences in Alberta so far.
