Health Care Aide program at Mayerthorpe Jr/Sr High School (MHS)

MHS' Dual Credit Health Care Aide program will continue to run this year for students who began the program in 2019-20. While the program has been a popular and successful opportunity for students, provincial funding changes have resulted in serious implications for Dual Credit programming. Consequently, NGPS is not accepting new enrollments in the program; however, students who were previously enrolled and had completed courses in the program will continue to be supported until they complete the program. Third party funding has been secured to support program completion for current Health Care Aide students.
