OUT-OF-DIVISION SPECIAL NEEDS PROGRAM SPONSORSHIP

Background

On occasion, special student needs require resident students to be enrolled in a program which is not readily accessible within the Division.

The Division may sponsor a resident special needs student to attend an out-of-Division educational program if a program that meets the educational needs of the student is not offered in the school or Division.

Procedures

- Sponsorship may include partial or complete costs associated with tuition fees, transportation and/or boarding allowances. Tuition fees may be considered, providing the program is not operated by a Board or private school being funded by Alberta Education.
- 2. Decisions related to sponsorship of out-of-Division programs will take into account the needs of the child as the primary consideration.
- 3. Decisions made regarding sponsorship for out-of-Division sponsorships may be appealed to the Board.
- 4. The Superintendent is responsible for approving out-of-Division sponsorships in accordance with the preceding procedures. Costs will be allocated to the appropriate school-based and Division accounts.
- 5. The Superintendent will inform the Board of each decision.
