

Administrative Procedure 802

GRANT INELIGIBLE TRANSPORTATION

Background

Circumstances may exist where it is appropriate for the Division to provide grant ineligible transportation services.

Procedures

- 1. Safety Considerations
 - 1.1 Eligibility for transportation is extended to those ineligible students who would otherwise have to walk along a road with a posted speed of 60 kilometers per hour or higher, without the benefit of sidewalks.
- 2. Over Age Students
 - 2.1 In exceptional circumstances, the Superintendent may approve transportation to over age students.
- 3. Pre-School Children
 - 3.1 The Superintendent may approve transportation for children to attend preschool programs in Division schools.
- 4. Temporary Situations
 - 4.1 When, during the school year, a student's residence changes to another school's attendance area within the Division, and the student wishes to continue to attend the school in which he/she registered at the start of the school year, the Superintendent will approve transportation for the remainder of the year at no cost only if:
 - 4.1.1 The service does not significantly affect the pick-up times, or ride times of other students, and;
 - 4.1.2 Transfers, if necessary, can be arranged.
 - 4.2 The Principal or Director of Transportation Services may approve requests for temporary transportation of students provided that:
 - 4.2.1 The request does not disrupt services for other students;
 - 4.2.2 There is sufficient seating accommodation on the bus; and





- 4.2.3 The bus route will not be altered to accommodate the request.
- 5. Winter Yard Service
 - 5.1 The Division does not provide winter yard service.
- 6. Exceptional Circumstances
 - 6.1 The Director of Transportation Services shall deal with any other exceptional circumstances on an individual basis, subject to the approval of the Superintendent.
