Wildfires Update

NGPS Superintendent Kevin Bird provided an update. Several NGPS communities have been impacted by wildfires and evacuation orders. Additional mental health supports have been allocated to communities dealing with the aftermath of evacuation.

Fox Creek remains under Evacuation Order this week and the school is closed for the week. We will re-assess the situation on the weekend.

In Valleyview, road closures are still impacting residents and bus service. Sturgeon Lake families are more heavily impacted with families having been evacuated to Grande Prairie and Edmonton and significant damages to Reserve infrastructure. Students will continue to be supported as needed.
