EDUCATIONAL REPORTING

Background

The Board and Superintendent recognize the legislated and ethical responsibility to keep stakeholders informed about accomplishments and progress toward the achievement of identified goals. The public will be kept informed of the accomplishments of the Division through the annual publishing of the Education Results Report.

Procedures

- The Superintendent will develop an Annual Education Results Report in accordance with Alberta Education policy and regulations, and submit it to the Board for approval. The Board approved report shall be submitted to Alberta Education in a form and at a time that meets requirements.
- 2. The Annual Education Results Report will contain information regarding progress toward meeting the goals and objectives established by the Education Plan.
- 4. The Annual Education Results Report will be posted on the Division website.
- 5. The Division shall use the Annual Education Results Report to inform the planning cycle in determining priorities, outcomes, measures and strategies of the Education Plan.
