2025-28 Three-Year Education Plan

Following final review, the Board approved the 2025-28 Three-Year Education Plan as presented. The Plan will be available on ngps.ca as of May 31, 2025.

2025-26 Division Budget

NGPS Secretary-Treasurer Tamara Spong reviewed 2025-26 budget allocations with trustees:

- 73% of the budget is delegated to Instruction;
- 12% to Operations and Maintenance;
- 9% to Transportation:
- 4% to System Administration and Governance; and,
- 1% each to Infrastructure and Maintenance Renewal Funding and External Programs.

The Board approved the 2025-26 Budget as presented, with note that the Division is running a deficit budget again this year, drawing from surplus funds (savings), to ensure NGPS students continue to have the educational supports, resources and opportunities they need.

Board Election - October 2025

Albertans vote for their School Board Trustees as part of the municipal general elections once every four years. The election for Alberta School Board Trustees will be Monday, October 20, 2025. Election information and nomination packages are available on ngps.ca.

NGPS Secretary-Treasurer and Electoral Returning Officer Tamara Spong recommended necessary updates to election related Board Policies, around items such as Voting Stations, Voting Hours and Advance Voting.

Motion was made to accept the updates as presented. Motion carried.

Alberta Public Survey to Inform the Selection and Availability of School Library Materials

The Alberta Minister of Education and Childcare announced this week that Alberta's government is considering <u>new standards</u> that would provide consistent requirements for school boards in selecting and managing school library collections. The government indicates that the changes are a response to an increasing number of concerns from parents and stakeholders regarding the availability of explicit content in some school libraries. The Minister is inviting Albertans and education partners to provide input on what they believe is acceptable for school library collections through an online survey, open until June 6, 2025.
