IT for Dominica

NGPS Director of Learning, Tammy Davis, joined the Board to share her experiences over the summer with IT for Dominica, a non-profit organization dedicated to advancing education and educational technology on the tiny Caribbean island of Dominica.

In 2017, Hurricane Maria engulfed and nearly destroyed the island. IT for Dominica stepped in to help restore internet/infrastructure and has been returning each year since with educators to teach technologies, and help build skills and capacity. Davis shared highlights from her time on the island, both as teacher and as learner, working with educators on digital citizenship, professional development, planning and leadership while learning about the culture, education, language and challenges of Dominicans.

Career Exposure Summer Camps

NGPS Director of Learning, Beth Jager, presented to the Board, sharing successes from the Division's Career Exposure Summer Camps. Over 300 students in Grades 9 through 12, from Onoway to Valleyview, signed up for the popular camps, earning high school credits this summer, for free, while exploring career paths and interests. Jager shared that the experience goes beyond credits, offering students a valuable opportunity to gain hands-on experience, to see if career paths are right for them, to get a head start on their careers, to build skills and resumes, and to generate motivation and excitement in learning.

Career Exposure Summer Camps are made possible by the efforts and investment of local and provincial partners, instructors, and educators who are passionate about supporting learners in our communities. Teacher/Labour Update

The Provincial Government and the Alberta Teachers' Association (ATA) have been in negotiations for several months. Last week, the ATA provided formal notice to begin labour action on Monday, October 6, 2025, if a settlement is not reached before that date. The notice given by the ATA is a general strike impacting all Alberta school divisions.

Job action may take different forms, including a full strike. If a full strike does occur:

- Students do not attend school and buses do not run
- Childcare programs in schools can continue to operate
- Junior Kindergarten programs continue to operate
- Joint use (school user groups such as a club that uses a school gym) continues to operate

NGPS remains hopeful that the Provincial Government and the ATA can reach a negotiated settlement soon. We are committed to keeping families and staff informed and will share updates through our website and social media as more information becomes available.


